














Every winter, about two million people come to Sapporo to see a large number of splendid snow statues and ice sculptures which line Odori Park and the main street in Susukino, Sapporo.

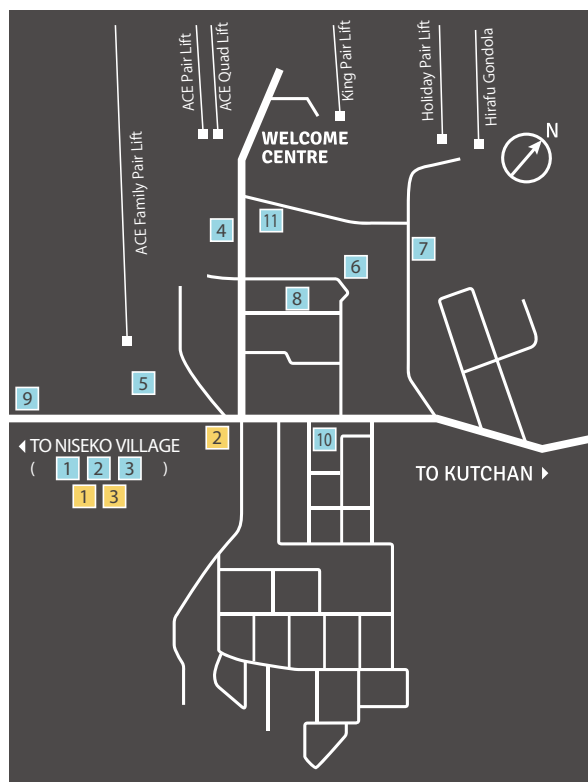

Rusutsu is one of Japan's most popular resorts, all year round. It takes just 90 minutes to travel by bus from Sapporo's Chitose International Airport, and one hour from Niseko. The main advantage Rusutsu has over other resorts in Hokkaido is the accessibility of the tree runs and back country. It's possible to ski straight off the lifts and into the best tree skiing in Hokkaido, and then ski straight back out onto the lifts. This means on any given day, you get more powder turns and thus more "bang for your buck".

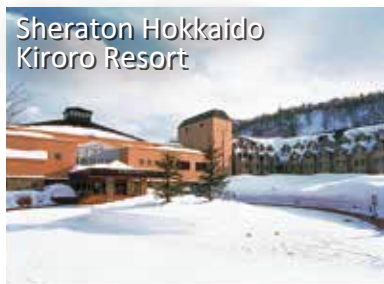

15th January 2020



Nozawa Onsen is home to the annual Dosojin Fire Festival. This famous event revolves around a six-storey wooden shrine that becomes the target of fire-bearing villagers. Male villagers (aged 42 years old) sit on the shrine atop a bed of pine branches looking on as more local men (aged 25 years old) defend the base bare-handed. Traditionally in Japan, these two ages have been considered unlucky and the event is a form of cleansing ritual. Eventually, the defenders concede defeat and the shrine is allowed to burn, producing a spectacular fiery display!

Mt. Myoko is one of the hundred most famous mountains in Japan, with its summit recorded as 2,454 meters above sea level. 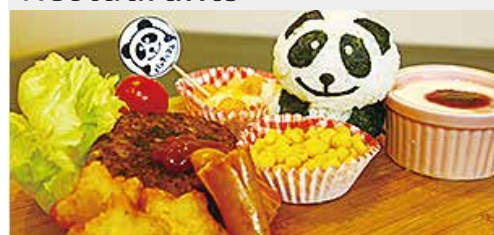
